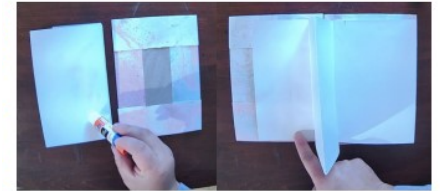
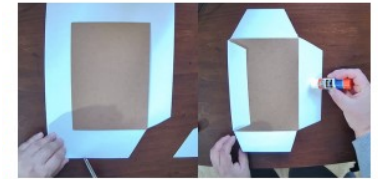




In the book, *Enchanted Air: Two Cultures, Two Wings*, Margarita describes her two worlds (Cuba and the United States) and how they relate to 2 historical events, the Cold War and the Cuban Missile Crisis. We invite you to make your own accordion book and explore two different perspectives on the back and front of the book.

STEPS TO MAKE YOUR BOOK

1. Use the planning guide on the other side of this paper to determine your theme and sketch your ideas for your book.
2. Assemble the book as follows:
 - Make the book covers: choose what color you want for each cover and glue the cardboard into the center of the paper. Trim the paper so you have 1 inch on all sides and cut off the corners of the paper.
 - Fold down the flaps and glue them into place. Repeat procedure for the 2nd cover.
 - Glue your book covers to each end of the paper accordion.
3. Using your ideas from the planning guide on the other side of this page, create your book.
 - If you are going to collage start with creating the backdrop- for example the sky, a nature scene, a cityscape, etc. Next add the images on top.
 - In addition to using the supplies in this kit, you can also cut out images from magazines.
 - Or you may choose to draw it comic book style, there are lots of options!
